

Product Name: Stabilised Chlorine Granules

Product Code: SP102

Product Description

A granular form of chlorine sanitiser that is dissolved in a bucket and poured into your pool/spa. Also used as a shock treatment on small above ground pools.

Dosing Instructions

Fill a clean plastic container with warm water and add the required amount of granules to the container. Stir well with a clean wooden or plastic stirrer. Once the granules are fully dissolved, distribute the solution around the pool.

Alternatively add the required amount of granules to the skimmer basket or strainer. If another chemical has been used prior to adding the granules wash out the skimmer basket or strainer thoroughly before adding granules. Never place granules directly into the pool, as severe bleaching/staining may occur.

Pool (Regular Dose)

To increase the free chlorine level by 1 part per million (ppm) add **100 grams per 10,000 gallons**. Check chlorine levels regularly with a test kit and maintain a chlorine level of 1 to 3 ppm.

Pool (Shock Dose)

For a shock dose add **750 grams per 10,000 gallons**. Please note this might need to be doubled or even trebled if algae is present. Check the chlorine level with a test kit and make sure the chlorine level is between of 1 and 3 ppm before re-entering the pool.

Spa

To increase the free chlorine level by 2.5 ppm add 5 grams (a teaspoon) per 1,000 litres of spa water. Check chlorine levels regularly with a test kit and maintain a chlorine level of 2 to 4 ppm.
