

**Product Name:** Stabilised 200g Chlorine Tablets

**Product Code:** SP122

### Product Description

A large tablet form of chlorine sanitiser for swimming pools that is placed in the skimmer basket or floating dispenser and slowly dissolves.

### Dosing Instructions

Remove plastic wrapping and place tablets in the skimmer basket or floating dispenser. Never place tablets directly into the pool, as severe bleaching or staining may occur.

If using a feeder or dispenser ensure that the tablets used are the same chemical (trichloroisocyanuric acid). If another material has been used before wash out the feeder thoroughly before adding tablets.

### Pool

**Skimmer:** 1 tablet per 10,000 gallons of pool water. It will take 5 to 7 days to dissolve.

**Floating dispenser:** Add 1 tablet per 7,000 gallons of pool water. It will take 10 to 14 days to dissolve. Check chlorine levels regularly with a test kit and maintain a chlorine residual of 1 to 3 parts per million (ppm). Once a fortnight (or once a week during the summer) boost the chlorine level with the addition of Chlorine Shock (Calcium Hypochlorite Granules).
