Product Description

A granular form of chlorine shock treatment for larger volume pools that are not emptied on a regular basis. Can also be used as a chlorine sanitiser for indoor pools.

Dosing Instructions

Warning: Calcium Hypochlorite will bleach clothes.

Fill a clean plastic container with warm water and add the required amount of Chlorine Shock granules to the container.

Stir well with a clean wooden or plastic stirrer. Some insoluble matter will remain and settle to the bottom of the container. Never place granules directly into the pool, as severe bleaching/staining may occur.

Pool (Shock Dose)

Once a fortnight (or more often in warmer weather), the pool should be SHOCK treated. **Add 500 grams (1 bag)** (1 scoop = 100g) per 10,000 gallons of pool water. If algae is present you may need to double or even treble the recommended dose.

Keep the filter free of debris and allow the water to circulate overnight. Allow the available chlorine to drop below 5 parts per million (ppm) before entering the pool. If this takes too long, excess chlorine can be removed using Dechlorinator.

Pool (Regular Sanitiser Dose)

To increase the free chlorine level by 1 part per million (ppm) add **75 grams per 10,000 gallons**. Check chlorine levels regularly with a test kit and maintain a chlorine of 1 to 3 parts per million (ppm).
