### **Dosing Instructions**

Warning: Bromine Tablets will bleach clothes.

Place tablets in the brominator, skimmer basket or floating dispenser. Never place tablets directly into the pool or spa, as severe bleaching or staining may occur.

If using a feeder or dispenser ensure that the tablets used are the same chemical (BCDMH). If another material has been used before, wash out the feeder thoroughly before adding tablets.

#### Pool

Place bromine tablets in the brominator or floating dispenser and adjust accordingly to maintain a bromine level of 2-4 parts per million (ppm).

# Spa

Put 2-5 tablets in a floating dispenser

and adjust the collar accordingly to maintain a bromine level of 3-6ppm. They will take 10-14 days to dissolve.
